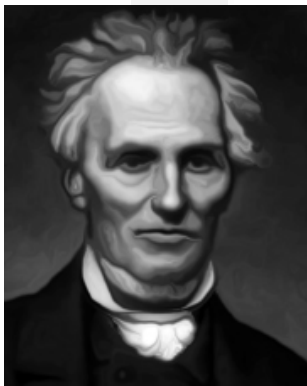
PURPOSE
